



**List of 11 plant *taxa* of the Cyprus Flora,  
that are considered to be non endemics to Cyprus anymore**

A/A	Family	Taxon	Comments
1	Apiaceae	<i>Ferula cypria</i> Post	The endemism of this species is controversial since the fact that Cyprus' plants and those of the species <i>Ferula elaeochytris</i> Korovin found in Libanon, Syria and Turkey is likely to belong to the same species <sup>1</sup> . If further investigation reveals that this is true, then the name <i>Ferula cypria</i> will be conserved.
2	Asparagaceae	<i>Hyacinthella millingenii</i> (Post) Feinbrun	The species is also found in Turkey <sup>2</sup> .
3	Brassicaceae	<i>Microthlaspi naticum</i> var. <i>pentadactylonis</i> F. K. Mey	The name is a synonym of the taxon <i>Microthlaspi naticum</i> subsp. <i>sporadium</i> F. K. Mey which is distributed in islands of East Aegean, Greece, Cyprus, Lebanon, Syria and Turkey <sup>2</sup> .
4	Cistaceae	<i>Helianthemum salicifolium</i> var. <i>glabrum</i> Meikle	The name is considered synonym of <i>Helianthemum salicifolium</i> (L.) Mill. which is not Cyprus endemic <sup>3</sup> .
5	Fabaceae	<i>Lathyrus blepharicarpus</i> var. <i>cyprius</i> Meikle	The name is a synonym of <i>Lathyrus blepharicarpus</i> Boiss. Distributed in Cyprus, Lebanon, Syria and Turkey <sup>2</sup> .

6	Lamiaceae	<i>Acinos exiguus</i> (Sm.) Meikle	The name is a synonym of taxon <i>Clinopodium graveolens</i> (M. Bieb.) Kuntze subsp. <i>graveolens</i> which is distributed in Europe and West Asia <sup>2</sup> .
7		<i>Origanum majorana</i> L.	The taxon is also found in Turkey <sup>2</sup> .
8	Lythraceae	<i>Lythrum hyssopifolia</i> var. <i>cypricum</i>	The name is a synonym <i>Lythrum hyssopifolia</i> L. which is widely distributed in Europe, West Asia and the northern part of Africa <sup>2</sup> .
9	Orchidaceae	<i>Orchis anatolica</i> var. <i>troodi</i>	The name is a synonym of <i>Orchis anatolica</i> Boiss. which is also found in Crete, Greece, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Syria and Turkey <sup>2,3</sup> .
10		<i>Epipactis troodi</i> H. Lindb.	The taxon also occurs in Crete and Turkey <sup>2</sup> .
11		<i>Serapias aphorditae</i> P. Delforge	The name is a synonym of <i>Serapias politisii</i> Renz which also occurs in Greece, Albania, Italy and Turkey <sup>2</sup> .
